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regard as so significant that it is likely to prejudice the member's judgement of the public interest. In such circumstances the member must withdraw from the meeting room and should inform the Chairman accordingly

3. It is not practicable to offer detailed advice during the meeting on whether a personal interest should be declared or whether a personal interest should also be regarded as prejudicial.
